News and views on disability issues

Disability awareness is a process of erasing fear and confusion and helping us understand disability issues. MUST Radio 107.8 FM along with NGO Trinayani have come up with a show to understand disability issues. The show called *Mur Mur Ke Na Dekh* is an one-hour weekly show hosted by Ritika Sahani. The aim of the show is to build and maintain a position in the media for people with disabilities.

The guests invited in this show include people with disability who are experts and have excelled in their field. The host and experts explore the lives of people with disabilities and highlight their strengths, enhance the self-esteem in them. The show also gives knowledge about the legal aspects like advocating human rights approach. The programme makes disable people aware of their rights, the government and corporate policies, and the various options available for them, through various organisations and institutes working towards the issues.

The show is aired every Saturday from 11.00 am-12.00 pm. The telecast is repeated in the evening from 6.00pm-7.00pm.

I have been associated with the MUST Radio 107.8 FM since a year and a half and it has been fantastic experience. In these successful years I am happy to be the voice of the community. I mostly do the evening show on the radio. I take up civil issues that people in the community are challenged with. In our show, we connect such people with the concerned authorities who can solve their issues.

Let me share an incident which happened during the election period. During that period, I received a call from a young man who said, he did not wish to vote for this Lok Sabha election. The man said, he has been hunting for a job as a lecturer since a long time. However, all educational institutions rejected his profile because of his disability. I wanted to take this to the next level. I then contacted the Corporator of the area the man belonged to, and requested the area Corporator to explain and give a solution to his problem. The on-air caller may not have been convinced hundred percent but he was shown a path on how to move forward which is very important.
